ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On September 2, 2020, Disciplinary Panel A (“Panel A”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Larry Gaston, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel A concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Gaston engaged in unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine and failed to provide details of a patient’s medical record upon request. Dr. Gaston was reprimanded, imposed a \$10,000.00 fine, and placed on probation for a minimum period of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions.

On September 30, 2022, Panel A and Dr. Gaston entered into a second Consent Order wherein Panel A concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Gaston failed to meet the appropriate standards for the delivery of quality medical care and failed to keep adequate medical records. Dr. Gaston was reprimanded, ordered to complete a course in record keeping, and permanently prohibited from prescribing and dispensing all Controlled Dangerous Substances (“CDS”), with an exception.

Dr. Gaston has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the September 2, 2020 and the September 30, 2022 Consent Orders.¹ It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the September 2, 2020 and September 30, 2022 Consent Orders is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Gaston is **PERMANENTLY PROHIBITED** from prescribing and dispensing all CDS with the following exception; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Gaston may issue CDS for treating patients for conditions that requires CDS, but the prescription may not exceed the lowest effective dose and quantity needed for a duration of **FIVE (5) DAYS**. The prescription may not be refilled, nor may it be renewed; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimands remain in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
