ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On February 10, 2022, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Haroldo Drachenberg, M.D. entered into a Consent Order wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Drachenberg was guilty of immoral and unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine and violated the Board's sexual misconduct regulations.

Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Panel suspended Dr. Drachenberg's license for a minimum of ten (10) business days, reprimanded him, and ordered that, upon the termination of suspension, he be placed on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions.

On February 25, 2022, after consideration of Dr. Drachenberg's petition to terminate his suspension, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation¹ that placed Dr. Drachenberg on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with terms and conditions, including enrollment in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program ("MPRP"), successfully complete a panel-approved course in Professional Boundaries and Ethics, and pay a civil fine of \$15,000.00 within two years.

Dr. Drachenberg has complied with the terms and conditions of probation, and two (2) years have passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the February 25, 2022, Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation is **TERMINATED**, and it is further
