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**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On July 13, 2020, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Melanie J. Sawhney, D.O. entered into a Consent Order wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Sawhney was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.

Under the terms of the Consent Order<sup>1</sup>, the Panel granted Dr. Sawhney's application to practice medicine and placed her on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with terms and conditions, including being supervised by a panel-approved board-certified physician for two (2) years, and successful completion of two (2) Board-approved courses in ethics and medical record-keeping. The Consent Order also provided that Dr. Sawhney may submit a written petition for termination of probation.

Dr. Sawhney has complied with the terms and conditions of probation, and two (2) years have passed. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the July 13, 2020 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**, and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; it is further
