Dear Dr. Gallagher and Counsel:

On April 17, 2012, the Board issued an **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE** in this case. Dr. Gallagher was given an opportunity to attend a hearing to show cause why that suspension should not be continued on April 25, 2012. Dr. Gallagher attended the hearing on that date together with his counsel, Conrad W. Varner, Esq. The State was represented by Dawn Rubin, Assistant Attorney General, Administrative Prosecutor. Both parties presented oral arguments at the show cause hearing.


After considering the presentations at the hearing, the Board determined that it would lift the summary suspension imposed on April 17, 2012. The Board has determined that the



arguments and documents submitted, and the responses to the Board's questions, significantly changed the Board's findings. The Board now concludes that there is no imminent danger to public health and safety posed by Dr. Gallagher practicing medicine at this time. The **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE** is therefore **VACATED**.

This letter constitutes an order of the Board resulting from formal disciplinary action and is therefore a public document.
