Dear Dr. Poss and Counsel:

On October 31, 2012, the Board issued an **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE** in this case. Dr. Poss was given an opportunity to attend a hearing on that issue on February 27, 2013. Dr. Poss attended the hearing on that date. The State was represented by Dawn Rubin and Christopher Anderson, Administrative Prosecutors.

After considering the presentations at the hearing, the Board determined that it would not lift the summary suspension first imposed on October 31, 2012. The Board concluded that the arguments submitted and the responses to the Board's questions did not significantly change the Board's findings or conclusions regarding the danger to the public which would be posed by Dr. Poss practicing medicine at this time. The Board advised Dr. Poss of this decision orally on the hearing date.

Under the Board regulations, Dr. Poss has the right to request a full evidentiary hearing before an Administrative Law Judge. This request will be granted if made it within ten days of the date of this letter. Any request for a hearing should be made to the Board at the above address. If Dr. Poss requests such a hearing, the regulations require that an Administrative Law Judge set the hearing to begin within 30 days of her request.


