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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On January 4, 2016, Disciplinary Panel A of the Maryland State Board of Physicians and Okechukwu Nwodim, M.D. entered into a public Consent Order.¹ Under the Consent Order, Dr. Nwodim was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of twelve months. In addition, Panel A ordered Dr. Nwodim to cease the practice of chronic pain management and limited Dr. Nwodim's prescribing of opioids to a maximum of three days and only in an emergency situation.² Dr. Nwodim has successfully complied with the probationary terms and conditions for a minimum of twelve months. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed under the January 4, 2016, Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that the prohibition from practicing chronic pain management and the limitation on opioid prescribing remain in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document pursuant to the Public Information Act,
