6. Policy -

Legislative Overview

Dr. Yemisi Koya, Ms. Sandy Van Horn, and Mr. Mark Woodward were available for questions concerning any proposed legislation.

Christine Farrelly informed the Board that Board staff revised the Naturopath regulations to remove all references to fees.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. S.C. Gupta</u> and seconded by <u>Ms. Baker</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> the revised Naturopathic Doctor regulations to move through the regulatory process.

Ms. Farrelly informed the Board that until the fees are resolved, the Board would be unable to issue licenses by March 1, 2016. However, Board staff are working with the NDs to receive credentials so that the Board is ready to license as soon as possible after the fee issue is resolved. The Board has begun the process to start emergency legislation to push back the licensure date.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. Della'Zanna</u> and seconded by <u>Ms. Baker</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>APPROVE</u> that staff continue the process for emergency legislation to push back the licensure date.

Ms. Ellen Douglas Smith presented a letter to the Board from the Chair of the Athletic Trainers Advisory Committee (ATAC). The letter asked the Board to support a legislative change to expedite the process for approving evaluation and treatment protocols. The ATAC is recommending a change that would allow Athletic Trainers to begin practicing upon the ATAC's written approval of the protocol. The protocols would still go to the Board for final approval.

On a motion made by <u>Dr. S.C. Gupta</u> and seconded by <u>Dr. Rosenstein</u>, the Board voted unanimously to <u>SUPPORT</u> this legislation.

BOARD VOTE TO CLOSE SESSION

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CLOSED SESSION: "Pursuant to Maryland State Government Annotated §10-501 et. seq., on a motion made by <u>Dr. S. C. Gupta</u> and seconded by <u>Ms. Contee</u>, the Board unanimously voted to close its meeting on February 10, 2016 at 9:40 a.m., in room 100 for the purpose of complying with the Maryland Medical Practice Act that prevents public disclosures about particular proceedings or matters. Pursuant to Md. Hth. Occ. Ann. 14-411 (a) and (b), the Board is prohibited from disclosing any information contained in a proceeding record or file of the Board."

SUMMARY OF CLOSED SESSION:

There were two cases presented to Panels A & B for charging. There was one case for Consideration of the Respondent's written Opposition to the Cease and Desist Order. There were three cases for Hospital Investigations, and Disciplinary Panel A & B closed meeting minutes for December 16, 2015, were approved.
