# Reducing Unhealthy Alcohol and Drug Use Among Patients at Office-Based Physician Practices

This training will introduce physicians to SBIRT, improve physician use of motivational techniques to change patient behavior, and provide practical tips for providing SBIRT services in busy office-based settings.

- ⇒ Formulate a framework for providing SBIRT services in office-based settings including the use of electronic health records, billing codes, etc.; and
- ⇒ Apply effective substance use screening and intervention within a busy primary care or specialty care practice.
