ORDER

On June 25, 2025, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Gary J. Sprouse, M.D., was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii); willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(11); made a willful misrepresentation in treatment, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(17); and willfully submitted false statements to collect fees for which services were not provided, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(23).¹ Under the terms and conditions of the Final Decision and Order, the Panel reprimanded Dr. Sprouse, suspended his Maryland medical license for a minimum period of six (6) months, and required him to complete a course in ethics during the minimum six (6) month suspension period. Additionally, the Final Decision and Order required Dr. Sprouse to pay a civil fine of \$35,000 within one (1) year of the effective date of the Final Decision and Order.²

On December 26, 2025, after fully and satisfactorily complying with all the terms and conditions of the suspension by the Final Decision and Order and six (6) months had passed, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Suspension that terminated the suspension and the terms and

conditions of the suspension imposed by the Final Decision and Order and ordered that the civil fine of \$35,000 to be paid within one (1) year remain in effect.

Dr. Sprouse has paid the \$35,000 civil fine.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the civil fine imposed by the June 25, 2025 Final Decision and Order has been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand imposed by the June 25, 2025 Final Decision and Order remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order³ is a public document.
