### **ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On April 11, 2019, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Wachsman failed to meet the appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review for the delivery of quality medical care in this State, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(22); failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(40); and had an unsatisfactory peer review, which constituted a violation of probation, under probationary condition 11 of the November 12, 2015 Consent Order.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Wachsman was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum period of five (5) years with probationary terms and conditions.

Dr. Wachsman has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the April 11, 2019 Final Decision and Order and five (5) years have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the April 11, 2019 Final Decision and Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimands imposed by the April 11, 2019 Final Decision and Order and November 12, 2015 Consent Order remain in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
