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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On April 8, 2026, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Osama Saleh, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Saleh failed to meet appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review for the delivery of quality medical and surgical care performed in an outpatient surgical facility, office, hospital, or any other location in this State, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(22); and failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(40).¹

Pursuant to the Consent Order, Dr. Saleh was reprimanded and placed on probation until he successfully completes a course in medical recordkeeping within six (6) months from the effective date of the Consent Order.

Dr. Saleh has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the April 8, 2026, Consent Order.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the April 8, 2026, Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
