**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On January 12, 2021, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians issued an *Order for Summary Suspension of License to Practice Medicine*, summarily suspending Ernest M. Myers, M.D.’s license to practice medicine. On January 28, 2021, the summary suspension was affirmed.

On February 26, 2021, the Panel and Dr. Myers entered into a *Consent Order*, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that he violated Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(4) by exhibiting professional, physical, or mental incompetence.<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to the Consent Order, the January 12, 2021, *Order for Summary Suspension of License to Practice Medicine* was terminated. Dr. Myers' license to practice medicine was placed on probation for a minimum period of five (5) years with the requirement that he enroll and comply with all of the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program’s (“MPRP”) referrals, rules, and requirements. Dr. Myers was also ordered to **PERMANENTLY** cease from performing any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, while the patient is under any form of sedation. Moreover, Dr. Myers was ordered to cease performing the following procedures unless and until the Board receives notification from MPRP that he is safe to resume:

- (a) any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, that in any way obstructs the upper airway;
- (b) any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, done on or through the tympanic membrane, in the middle ear, or in the inner ear;
- (c) any type of sinus surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting; and
- (d) any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, that has an anticipated blood loss greater than 10cc.

Dr. Myers has fully and satisfactorily complied with the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the February 26, 2021, *Consent Order*, and five (5) years have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the February 26, 2021, *Consent Order* is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Dr. Myers is **PERMANENTLY** prohibited from performing any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, while the patient is under any form of sedation; and it is further,

**ORDERED** that the restricted procedures outlined in the February 26, 2021, *Consent Order* remain in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that, for as long as he holds a Maryland medical license, Dr. Myers shall provide an annual affidavit on every January 31<sup>st</sup> thereafter, verifying the following: he has not performed any surgery or procedure, including those in an office-based setting, while the patient is under any form of sedation or any of the restricted procedures outlined in this Order; and it is further

**ORDERED** that if Dr. Myers fails to provide the required annual verification of compliance:

1. There will be a presumption that Dr. Myers has violated the permanent condition and the prohibition on performing the restricted procedures; and
2. The alleged violation will be adjudicated pursuant to the procedures of a Show Cause Hearing; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
