ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On October 18, 2023, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Nasima N. Jaffery, M.D., entered into a Consent Order (the “Order”), wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Jaffery was guilty of failing to meet the appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review for the delivery of quality medical care performed in this State, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(22).¹ Dr. Jaffery was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum period of two (2) years and ordered to successfully complete courses in prescribing Controlled Dangerous Substances (“CDS”) and medical record-keeping within six (6) months. Additionally, the Order permanently prohibited her from prescribing, dispensing, and administering all CDS and from certifying patients for the medical use of cannabis and ordered that on every January 31st thereafter if she holds a Maryland medical license that she provides the Board with an affidavit verifying that she has not prescribed, dispensed, and administered any CDS and has not certified any patients for the medical use of cannabis.

Dr. Jaffery has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the October 18, 2023 Consent Order and two (2) years have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the October 18, 2023 Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that the permanent prohibitions of Dr. Jaffery: (1) prescribing, dispensing, and administering all CDS; and (2) certifying patients for the medical use of cannabis and the January 31st affidavit remain in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that if Dr. Jaffery fails to provide the required annual verification of compliance with the permanent prohibitions on prescribing, administering and dispensing CDS and certifying patients for the medical use of cannabis:

- (1) there is a presumption that Dr. Jaffery has violated the permanent condition; and
- (2) the alleged violation will be adjudicated pursuant to the procedure of a Show Cause Hearing; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
