ORDER TERMINATING SUSPENSION

On December 18, 2025, pursuant to Health Occ. § 14-3A-01, Interstate Medical Licensure Compact, Section 10, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued an Order regarding Joel S. Jones, D.O. based upon an October 31, 2025 Consent Order entered into by the North Carolina Medical Board (the “North Carolina Board”). Based on the North Carolina Board’s Conclusions of Law, the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Jones was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii).¹

Pursuant to the Maryland Board Order, the Panel suspended Dr. Jones’ medical license in the State of Maryland for six (6) months, ordered that he not serve as a collaborating physician for a physician assistant in Maryland, and ordered that he comply with the terms and conditions of the October 31, 2025 North Carolina Board Consent Order.²

The North Carolina Board has administratively terminated the suspension of Dr. Jones’ license to practice medicine in the state of North Carolina and maintained his restriction from serving as the supervising physician for any advanced practice providers (“APPs”) in North Carolina.

² The October 31, 2025 North Carolina Consent Order suspended Dr. Jones’ license to practice medicine for six (6) months and restricted him from serving as the supervising physician for any advanced practice providers (“APPs”) in North Carolina.

Dr. Jones is in compliance with all terms and conditions imposed by the December 18, 2025 Maryland Board Order and six (6) months have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the suspension imposed by the December 18, 2025 Maryland Board Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Jones shall not serve as a collaborating physician for a physician assistant in Maryland until the restriction terms and conditions of him serving as the supervising physician for any APPs in North Carolina in the October 31, 2025 North Carolina Board Consent Order is terminated.; and it is further

ORDERED that Dr. Jones shall continue to comply with the terms and conditions of the October 31, 2025 North Carolina Board Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order Terminating Suspension shall not be amended or modified and future request for modification will not be considered; and it is further

ORDERED that the effective date of the Order Terminating Suspension is the date the Order Terminating Suspension is signed by the Executive Director of the Board or her designee. The Executive Director or her designee signs the Order Terminating Suspension on behalf of the disciplinary panel which has imposed the terms and conditions of this Order Terminating Suspension; and it is further

ORDERED that, if Dr. Jones allegedly fails to comply with any term or condition imposed by this Order Terminating Suspension, Dr. Jones shall be given notice and an opportunity for a hearing. If the disciplinary panel determines there is a genuine dispute as to a material fact, the hearing shall be before an Administrative Law Judge of the Office of Administrative Hearings followed by an exceptions process before a disciplinary panel; and if the disciplinary panel

determines there is no genuine dispute as to a material fact, Dr. Jones shall be given a show cause hearing before a disciplinary panel; and it is further

ORDERED that, after the appropriate hearing, if the disciplinary panel determines that Dr. Jones has failed to comply with any term or condition imposed by this Order Terminating Suspension, the disciplinary panel may reprimand Dr. Jones, place Dr. Jones on probation with appropriate terms and conditions, or suspended Dr. Jones' license with appropriate terms and conditions or revoke Dr. Jones' license. The disciplinary panel may, in addition to one or more of the sanctions set for above, impose a civil monetary fine on Dr. Jones, and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
