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**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On July 28, 2025, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Chris Burkovich, Radiographer (the “Respondent”), entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that the Respondent was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of radiation therapy, radiography, nuclear medicine technology, or radiology assistance, in violation of Health Occ. §§ 14-5B-14(a)(3).<sup>1</sup>

Pursuant to the Consent Order, the Respondent was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with the following terms and conditions: 1) enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) and comply with all of its rules, referrals, and requirements, and 2) complete a course in Professional Boundaries within six (6) months from the effective date of the Consent Order.

The Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the July 28, 2025, Consent Order, and one (1) year has passed.

It is, thus, by Panel A, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the July 28, 2025, Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
