## ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On April 21, 2023, Disciplinary Panel B (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Kevin M. Meadowcroft, P.A., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Mr. Meadowcroft was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 15-314(a)(3)(ii). Mr. Meadowcroft was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year, ordered to successfully complete a course in professional boundaries within six (6) months and pay a civil fine of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) within one (1) year.

On May 13, 2024, the Panel issued an Order After Show Cause Hearing (the "Order"), wherein it was concluded as a matter of law, that Mr. Meadowcroft violated the April 21, 2023 Consent Order by failing the PROBE: Ethics and Boundaries Program course offered by the Center for Personalized Education for Professionals ("CPEP").

Under the terms of the Order, the Panel **TERMINATED** the probation imposed in the April 21, 2023 Consent Order, ordered that Mr. Meadowcroft's \$5,000 civil fine was satisfied and that the reprimand imposed by the Consent Order remain in effect. Additionally, the Order reprimanded him, placed him on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with certain probationary terms and conditions, including that he re-enrolls in and successfully completes the

CPEP professional boundaries course and that he enrolls in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program.

Mr. Meadowcroft has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the Order After Show Cause Hearing Order and one (1) year has passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the
May 13, 2024 Order After Show Cause Hearing Order are TERMINATED; and it is further
ORDERED that the reprimands imposed by the May 13, 2024 Order After Show Cause
Hearing and the April 21, 2023 Consent Order remain in effect; and it is further
OREDERED that this a public document.
