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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On June 30, 2016, Allyson L. Conley, PA-C, entered into a Consent Order with Disciplinary Panel B (“Panel B”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians wherein Panel B concluded, as a matter of law, that Ms. Conley had fraudulently or deceptively used a license, engaged in unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, was addicted to or habitually used a narcotic or controlled dangerous substance, provided professional services while using a narcotic or controlled dangerous substance, and willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine. The Consent Order suspended Ms. Conley’s license to practice as a Physician Assistant (“PA”), retroactive to November 10, 2015, and required that she comply with certain terms and conditions.

On October 24, 2016, Panel B issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the suspension of Ms. Conley’s PA license and placed her on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions. Ms. Conley has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the October 24, 2016 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the October 24, 2016 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
