ORDER

On May 15, 2020, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians and Rosemary Ingado, PA-C, entered into a Consent Order wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Ms. Ingado, had failed to meet the appropriate standards for the delivery of quality medical care and failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review.¹ The Consent Order reprimanded Ms. Ingado and placed her on probation for a minimum of eighteen (18) months with certain terms and conditions. Ms. Ingado has complied with the terms and conditions of the probation and eighteen (18) months have passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the May 15, 2020 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
