ORDER

On December 14, 2017, Disciplinary Panel B (“Panel B”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Maria Shesiuk, PA-C, entered into a Consent Order, wherein Ms. Shesiuk’s license was suspended and she was required to enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) for evaluation, treatment and monitoring.¹

On March 9, 2018, the Board issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation² that terminated the suspension of Ms. Shesiuk’s license and placed Ms. Shesiuk on probation for a minimum of three (3) years with terms and conditions. The Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation stated that Panel B would consider a petition for early termination of probation after one year, if Ms. Shesiuk enters into a disposition agreement with the Board or Panel B that would require her to remain enrolled in monitoring through MPRP and in compliance with Conditions 1-4 as set forth in the Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation. On March 15, 2019, Ms. Shesiuk petitioned for early termination of probation through the provision above.

On April 24, 2019, Panel B considered all relevant documents, to include a letter from MPRP regarding Ms. Shesiuk’s participation and compliance with the program and her petition.

Ms. Shesiuk has complied with the probationary terms and conditions of the Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation, there are no pending complaints related to the charges, and Ms. Shesiuk has entered into a disposition agreement with Panel B, in accordance with the March 9, 2018 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the March 9, 2018 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. §§ 4-101 *et seq.* (2014 & 2017 Supp.).
