**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On September 2, 2020, Collina O. Afriyie, PA-C and Disciplinary Panel A (“Panel A”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) entered into a Consent Order, in which Panel A concluded, as a matter of law, that Ms. Afriyie was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, prescribed drugs for illegal or illegitimate purposes, performed delegated medical acts beyond the scope of the delegation agreement filed with the Board, and performed delegated medical acts without the supervision of a physician. Pursuant to the Consent Order, Panel A suspended Ms. Afriyie’s physician assistant license for a minimum period of six (6) months and required that she comply with certain terms and conditions.<sup>1</sup>

On April 23, 2021, Panel A issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the suspension of Ms. Afriyie’s physician assistant license and placed her on probation for a minimum of six (6) months with certain terms and conditions.<sup>2</sup>

Ms. Afriyie has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the April 23, 2021 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation.

It is thus hereby
