ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On October 18, 2022, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dora Logue, M.D., was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, and violated a rule or regulation adopted by the Board, or any State or federal law pertaining to the practice of medicine.¹ Dr. Logue was reprimanded and placed on probation with certain terms and conditions, including enrolling in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) and complying with all referrals and recommendations with MPRP, completing courses in Implicit Bias, Patient Confidentiality, and Professional Boundaries within six (6) months, and paying a fine of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) within one (1) year.

Dr. Logue has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the October 18, 2022 Final Decision and Order.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the October 18, 2022 Final Decision and Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further
