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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On October 17, 2022, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Ronald A. Miller, M.D. entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Miller failed to meet appropriate standards as determined by appropriate peer review for the delivery of quality medical and surgical care and failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review.¹ Dr. Miller was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of one year with certain terms and conditions, including that he successfully complete courses in medical recordkeeping and prescribing opioids and benzodiazepines within six months, that he obtain a panel-approved supervisor board-certified in Internal Medicine, and that he was prohibited from prescribing and dispensing opioids and benzodiazepines until he successfully completed the required courses and obtained a supervisor.

On April 4, 2023, based upon Dr. Miller completing the required courses and the Panel approving Dr. Miller’s proposed supervisor, the Panel issued a Terminating Order, wherein the Panel terminated the prohibition on Dr. Miller’s ability to prescribe and dispense opioids and benzodiazepines and ordered Dr. Miller to be supervised for a minimum period of one (1) year

by his approved supervisor. Furthermore, the probation imposed by the October 17, 2022 Consent remained in effect.

Dr. Miller has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions imposed by the October 17, 2022 Consent Order and April 4, 2023 Termination Order and one (1) year has passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the October 17, 2022 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
