ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On March 21, 2025, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Jason Atwood Tate, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Tate was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii).

Pursuant to the Consent Order, Dr. Tate was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum period of six (6) months with the following terms and conditions: 1) successfully complete courses in: (i) medical ethics, and (ii) prescribing of controlled substances and 2) pay a civil fine of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), all within six (6) months from the effective date of the Consent Order.

Dr. Tate has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the March 21, 2025, Consent Order, and six (6) months have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the March 21, 2025, Consent Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
