**ORDER**

On March 8, 2023, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and David N. Ijeh, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Ijeh violated §14-316(c) of the Health Occupations Article and COMAR 10.32.01.10C(1) by failing to obtain the requisite continuing medical education credits.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Ijeh was ordered to pay a civil fine of four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500.00) within thirty (30) days and required to obtain the required 50 credit mandatory hours of Category I CME for his 2024 medical license renewal and the outstanding 45 hours of Category I CME credits that were not obtained during his 2022 renewal. Dr. Ijeh has paid the \$4,500.00 civil fine and completed the Category I CME credits. It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the fine and Category I CME credit requirements imposed by the March 8, 2023 Consent Order have been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT**.
