ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On October 17, 2017, after concluding that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively required emergency action and voting to summarily suspended the medical license of Daniel J. Bochicchio, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Dr. Bochicchio, entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively required emergency action and that Dr. Bochicchio was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, was professionally, physically, or mentally incompetent, was addicted to, or habitually abuses, any narcotic or controlled dangerous substance, willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine; and was disciplined by any branch of the United States uniformed services or the Veterans' Administration for an act that would be ground for disciplinary action. The Consent Order suspended Dr. Bochicchio's State of Maryland medical license with terms and conditions, including that he enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program ("MPRP") and comply with all of MPRP's referrals, rules and requirements. The Consent Order further ordered that Dr. Bochicchio may petition the Panel to terminate the suspension once MPRP determined that he was safe to return to the practice medicine and that, if the Panel terminated the suspension, the Panel could impose conditions on Dr. Bochicchio's return to practice.

On September 26, 2019, after consideration of Dr. Bochicchio's petition to terminate his suspension, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the suspension of Dr. Bochicchio's license imposed by the October 17, 2017 Consent Order and ordered that he be placed on probation for a minimum of five (5) years, which included continued participation in MPRP and prohibition from practicing general anesthesia and surgery or prescribing any Controlled Dangerous Substances ("CDS") for a minimum of one (1) year. Panel A also determined that, after one (1) year, Dr. Bochicchio shall be reevaluated by MPRP or its agents to determine whether he is safe to resume the practice of general anesthesia and surgery and resume prescribing CDS.

On January 6, 2021, after a reevaluation by MPRP or its agents that determined Dr. Bochicchio was safe to resume the practice of general anesthesia and surgery and resume prescribing CDS, the Panel issued a Termination Order¹ that terminated the prohibition restrictions from practicing general anesthesia and surgery and from prescribing any CDS imposed by the September 26, 2019 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation. The Termination Order further ordered that the probation for a minimum of five (5) years imposed by the September 26, 2019 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation remain in effect which included that he remains enrolled in MPRP and cooperate and comply with all MPRP's referrals, rules and requirements, including, but not limited to the terms and conditions of the Participant Rehabilitation Agreement(s) and Participant Rehabilitation Plan(s) entered with MPRP.

Dr. Bochicchio has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the September 26, 2019 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation and January 6, 2021 Termination Order, and five (5) years have passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the September 26, 2019 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation and January 6, 2021 Terminating Order are **TERMINATED** and it is further
