ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On March 9, 2021, Disciplinary Panel B (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") issued a Final Decision and Order that concluded that Paul J. Mackoul, M.D. had engaged in unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, grossly overutilized health care services, and failed to meet appropriate standards of care for the delivery of quality medical care. Pursuant to the Final Decision and Order, Dr. Mackoul's license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland was suspended for a minimum of one (1) month, effective thirty (30) calendar days from the effective date of the Order. The Final Decision and Order also provided that, upon termination of the suspension, the Respondent shall be placed on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with terms and conditions.

On May 10, 2021, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation,¹ wherein the Panel terminated the suspension imposed by the March 9, 2021 Final Decision and Order and placed Dr. Mackoul on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with the following terms and conditions: (1) successfully complete an ethics course addressing ethical issues and human participant protection in human subject research within three (3) months; (2) shall not engage in any human subject research during the first year of probation; (3) required to submit research protocol and IRB approval to the Board for review should he engage in human

subject research during the second year of probation; and (4) shall pay a civil fine of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) within two (2) years.

Dr. Mackoul has fully and satisfactorily complied with all terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation and two (2) years have passed. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the May 10, 2021, Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation is **TERMINATED**, and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
