**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On October 14, 2021, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Paul A. Law, M.D. entered into a Consent Order,<sup>1</sup> wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Law was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine, violated the Board’s sexual misconduct regulations found in COMAR 10.32.17 *et seq.*, and, except for the licensure process under Subtitle 3A of this title, violated any rule or regulation adopted by the Board, specifically the Board’s sexual misconduct regulations. The Consent Order reprimanded Dr. Law and placed him under probation for a minimum period of three (3) years with the following terms and conditions: 1) within one (1) year, pay a civil fine of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), 2) within six (6) months, successfully complete a course on boundaries for physicians, and 3) that he enrolls in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) and comply with all of MPRP’s referrals, rules, and requirements.

Dr. Law has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation imposed by the Consent Order, and three (3) years have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the Consent Order are **TERMINATED** and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
