**CONSENT ORDER**

**PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND**

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the “Maryland Board”) received information that Lisa Kim Majete, M.D., (the “Respondent”) License Number D0071589, was disciplined by the Virginia Board of Medicine (the “Virginia Board”)<sup>1</sup>. In an Order dated June 26, 2024, the Virginia Board disciplined the Respondent by reprimand and assessed a monetary penalty.

Based on the above referenced Virginia Board sanction, the Maryland Board has grounds to charge the Respondent with violating the following provisions of the Maryland Medical Practice Act (the “Act”), under H. O. § 14-404(a):

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:
  - (21) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country or disciplined by any branch of the United States uniformed services or the Veteran’s Administration for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section,

Disciplinary Panel A ("Panel A") has determined that the acts for which the Respondent was disciplined in Virginia would be grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a). The grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a) are as follows:

- (18) Practices medicine with an unauthorized person or aids an unauthorized person in the practice of medicine;
- (43) Except for the licensure process described under Subtitle 3A of this title, violates any provision of this title, any rule or regulation adopted by the Board, or any State or federal law pertaining to the practice of medicine;

According to Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 10.32.09.09

- (A) A physician may be disciplined for any of the following:
  - (1) Delegating assigning, or supervising a cosmetic medical procedure performed by an individual who is not a physician assistant or another licensed health care provider whose licensing board has determined that the procedure is within the scope of practice of the individual;

Based on the action taken by the Virginia Board, the Respondent agrees to enter into this Consent Order with Panel A, consisting of Procedural Background, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Order and Consent.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

Panel A makes the following findings of fact:

1. At all times relevant hereto, the Respondent was a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maryland. The Respondent was initially licensed in Maryland on or about November 12, 2010.
2. In its June 26, 2024 Consent Order, the Virginia Board found that the Respondent, by her own admission, on three occasions authorized a medical assistant, who is not a licensed health care practitioner, to administer Juvederm and/or Botox

cosmetic injections to Individual A without completing an in-person examination of that individual.

3. The Virginia Board also found the Respondent allowed the medical assistant to provide care without sufficient direct and immediate supervision.

4. By Order dated June 26, 2024, the Virginia Board disciplined the Respondent by reprimand and assessed a monetary penalty.

A copy of the Virginia Board Order is attached hereto.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, Panel A concludes as a matter of law that the Respondent is subject to discipline under Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(21) for the disciplinary action taken by the Board against the Respondent for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action under Health Occ. §14-404(a)(18) and (43) as well as § COMAR 10.32.09.09(A)(1).

### **ORDER**

It is, thus, by Panel A, hereby:

**ORDERED** that the Respondent is hereby **REPRIMANDED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the effective date of the Consent Order is the date the Consent Order is signed by the Executive Director of the Board or her designee. The Executive Director or her designee signs the Consent Order on behalf of the disciplinary panel which has imposed the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent is responsible for all costs incurred in fulfilling the terms and conditions of this Consent Order; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this Consent Order is a public document. *See* Health Occ. §§1-607, 14-411.1(b)(2) and Gen. Prov. §4-333(b)(6).

I waive those procedural and substantive protections. I acknowledge the legal authority and the jurisdiction of the disciplinary panel to initiate these proceedings and to issue and enforce this Consent Order.

I voluntarily enter into and agree to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the Consent Order as a resolution of the charges. I waive any right to contest the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Order set out in the Consent Order. I waive all rights to appeal this Consent Order.

I sign this Consent Order, without reservation, and fully understand the language and meaning of its terms.
