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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On February 17, 2021, Disciplinary Panel A (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Sarah Pryor, M.D. entered into a non-public Disposition Agreement (the “Agreement”), wherein Dr. Pryor agreed to enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”), comply with all of MPRP’s recommendations, and fulfill all conditions of the Participant Rehabilitation Agreement (“PRA”).

On February 23, 2022, after the Panel issued a Violation of Board Order and Notice to Show Cause and after a Show Cause Hearing, the Panel issued an Order After Show Cause Hearing (the “Order”), wherein it was concluded as a matter of law, that Dr. Pryor violated the terms and conditions of the Agreement by failing to comply with terms of her MPRP PRA. The Order terminated the February 17, 2021 Agreement, reprimanded her, and placed her on probation for a minimum period of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions, including that she remain enrolled in MPRP, comply with all of MPRP’s recommendations, and fulfill all conditions of the PRA.

Dr. Pryor has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and two (2) years have passed. It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the February 23, 2022 Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand imposed by the February 23, 2022 Order remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
