**ORDER**

On June 6, 2024, Disciplinary Panel B (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Brandon M. Wachal, M.D. entered into a Consent Order<sup>1</sup>, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Wachal violated the Maryland Medical Practice Act (the "Act"), Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. ("Health Occ.") §§ 14-101 *et seq.* (2021 Repl. Vol. & 2023 Supp.) by serving as a Supervising Physician for a physician assistant who practiced without a Board Approved Delegation Agreement for Core Duties and failed to properly file said delegation agreement with the Board for approval, in violation of Health Occ. § 15-314(a)(43).

Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Panel reprimanded Dr. Wachal and ordered him to pay a \$1,000.00 civil fine within six (6) months.

Dr. Wachal has complied with the terms and conditions of the Consent Order. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the terms and conditions imposed by the June 6, 2024, Consent Order are **SATISFIED**, and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect and it is further
