ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On January 24, 2022, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Mehayar H. Torghabeh, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Torghabeh was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.¹ Dr. Torghabeh was granted licensure, reprimanded, and placed on probation until he had fully complied with the terms and conditions of the Stipulation for a Probationary License issued by the Medical Board of California (the “California Board”) on November 9, 2021.

On November 15, 2024, the California Board fully restored Dr. Torghabeh’s license.

Dr. Torghabeh has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the November 9, 2021 California Board Stipulation for a Probationary License.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the Maryland January 24, 2022 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
