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ORDER

On May 10, 2024, Disciplinary Panel A (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Dr. Reitzenstein entered into a Consent Order¹, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Reitzenstein failed to complete the Supplement Application for his Compact License in violation of Health Occ. §§ 14-404(a)(43) and 14-313.1(a).

Under the terms of the Consent Order, the Panel reprimanded Dr. Reitzenstein and required payment of a \$500.00 civil fine within thirty (30) days. Dr. Reitzenstein was also required to complete and submit a Supplemental Compact License Application within ten (10) business days.

Dr. Reitzenstein has complied with the terms and conditions of the Consent Order. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the terms and conditions imposed by the May 10, 2024, Consent Order are **SATISFIED**, and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
