**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On April 11, 2024, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and James Juhng, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Juhng was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, willfully made or filed a false report or record in the practice of medicine, and willfully made a false representation when seeking or making application for licensure or any other application related to the practice of medicine.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Juhng was granted licensure, reprimanded, and placed on probation with certain terms and conditions, including enrolling in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”) and complying with all referrals and recommendations made by MPRP. Dr. Juhng has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the April 11, 2024 Consent Order. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the April 11, 2024 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
