ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On November 18, 2020, Disciplinary Panel B (the "Panel") of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and Hamid Tabatabai, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel B concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Tabatabai was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, and violated the Board's sexual misconduct regulations located in Code of Maryland Regulations 10.32.17.03A ([h]ealth care practitioners may not engage in sexual misconduct), promulgated pursuant to Health Occ. § 1-212(a)(1) (prohibiting sexual misconduct).¹ Dr. Tabatabai was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum period of three (3) years, and required to comply with certain terms and conditions. Dr. Tabatabai has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the November 18, 2020 Consent Order. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the November 18, 2020 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
