ORDER

On March 24, 2022, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Lawrence Vidaver, M.D., entered into a Consent Order wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Vidaver had failed to meet the appropriate standards for the delivery of quality medical care and failed to keep adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review.¹ The Consent Order reprimanded Dr. Vidaver, permanently prohibited him from prescribing and dispensing all Controlled Dangerous Substances (“CDS”), effective six (6) months from the date of the Consent Order, required that he provide documentation to the Board demonstrating that he has transferred his patients being prescribed CDS to other providers, and placed him on probation for one (1) year with terms and conditions. Dr. Vidaver has complied with the terms and conditions of probation, one (1) year has passed, and he has provided documentation demonstrating that he has transferred his patients being prescribed CDS to other providers. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the March 24, 2022 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the permanent prohibition on Dr. Vidaver’s ability to prescribe CDS remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that on every January 31st hereafter if Dr. Vidaver holds an active Maryland medical license, he shall provide the Board with an affidavit verifying that he has not prescribed or dispensed any CDS in the past year; and it is further

ORDERED that if Dr. Vidaver fails to provide the required annual verification of compliance with this condition:

1. There is a presumption that he has violated the permanent condition; and
2. The alleged violation will be adjudicated pursuant to the procedures of a Show Cause Hearing; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
