**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On December 2, 2019, Disciplinary Panel A of the Maryland State Board of Physicians and Michael Morris, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel B concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Morris had grossly overutilized health care services, failed to meet the standards of quality medical care, and failed to maintain adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review. Pursuant to the Consent Order, Dr. Morris was reprimanded, would be placed on probation for a minimum of one (1) year following his successful completion of courses on medical documentation and infectious diseases, and was required to comply with certain terms and conditions.

On April 21, 2020, following Dr. Morris' completion of the two (2) required courses, the Board issued an Order Commencing Probation that began the probation effective April 15, 2020 and reiterated the reprimand and remaining terms and conditions of the December 2019 Consent Order.

On November 2, 2020, Panel A and Dr. Morris entered into a second Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Morris had grossly overutilized health care services, failed to meet the standards of quality medical care, and failed to maintain adequate medical records as determined by appropriate peer review for a different set of patients that were reviewed in a separate investigation from the one that resulted in the December 2019 Consent Order. Pursuant to the new Consent Order, the December 2019 Consent Order was terminated, Dr. Morris was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum of one (1) year, and was subject to certain terms and conditions.<sup>1</sup>

Dr. Morris has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the November 2, 2020 Consent Order. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the November 2, 2020 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a public document.
