**ORDER**

On November 2, 2006, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (“Board”) found Craig S. Cropp, M.D., in violation of the Medical Practice Act for being disciplined by the Virginia Board of Medicine for acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action<sup>1</sup> if performed in this State and suspended his license to practice medicine. *See* Md. Code Ann., Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(21). During the pendency of this action, Dr. Cropp’s license expired.

On October 23, 2017, Dr. Cropp applied for reinstatement of his license. On January 4, 2018, the Board issued an Order of Reinstatement, which reinstated Dr. Cropp’s license to practice medicine and placed Dr. Cropp on probation for a minimum period of one year with certain terms and conditions.<sup>2</sup> Dr. Cropp has successfully completed the terms and conditions of probation. Thus, it is hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the Order of Reinstatement, dated January 4, 2018 is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT**.
