### **CONSENT ORDER**

### PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

The Maryland Board of Physicians (the "Maryland Board") received information that Sunday C. Uchella, M.D., (the "Respondent") License Number D47415, was disciplined by the Virginia Board of Medicine (the "Virginia Board"). In an Order dated September 17, 2020, the Virginia Board reprimanded the Respondent.

Based on the above referenced Virginia Board sanction, the Maryland Board has grounds to charge the Respondent with violating the following provisions of the Maryland Medical Practice Act (the "Act"), under H. O. § 14-404(a):

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of § 14-405 of this subtitle, a disciplinary panel, on the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum of the disciplinary panel, may reprimand any licensee, place any licensee on probation, or suspend or revoke a license if the licensee:
  - (21) Is disciplined by a licensing or disciplinary authority or convicted or disciplined by a court of any state or country or disciplined by any branch of the United States uniformed services or the Veteran's Administration for an act that would be grounds for disciplinary action under this section,

The Maryland Board has determined that the acts for which the Respondent was disciplined in Virginia would be grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a). The grounds for disciplinary action under H.O. § 14-404(a) are as follows:

- (3) Is guilty of:
  - (ii) Unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine.

Based on the action taken by the Virginia Board, the Respondent agrees to enter into this Consent Order with the Maryland Board of Physicians, consisting of Procedural Background, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order of reciprocal action.

#### I. FINDINGS OF FACT

The Board finds the following:

- 1. At all times relevant hereto, the Respondent was a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maryland. The Respondent was initially licensed in Maryland on or about May 26, 1995.
- 2. On or about April 25, 2020, while on duty as a contract physician in a pediatric unit of a Virginia hospital, the Respondent practiced intubation four times on a stillborn infant without parental consent.
- 3. By Order dated September 17, 2020, the Virginia Board reprimanded the Respondent.

A copy of the Virginia Order is attached hereto.

#### II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Maryland Board concludes as a matter of law that the disciplinary action taken by the Virginia Board against the Respondent was for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action under Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(3)(ii) had those offenses been committed in this state, and would thus subject him to discipline under Health Occ. § 14-404(a)(21).

### III. ORDER

It is hereby:

**ORDERED** that the Respondent be and is hereby **REPRIMANDED**; and be it further

ORDERED that this CONSENT ORDER is a PUBLIC DOCUMENT pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. §§4-101 through 4-601 (2014).

I voluntarily enter into and agree to comply with the terms and conditions set forth in the Consent Order as a resolution of the charges. I waive any right to contest the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Order set out in the Consent Order. I waive all rights to appeal this Consent Order.

#### CONSENT ORDER

### JURISDICTION AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") and Sunday Chinasaokwu Uchella, M.D., as evidenced by their signatures hereto, in lieu of proceeding to an informal conference, enter into the following Consent Order affecting Dr. Uchella's license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

# FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Sunday Chinasaokwu Uchella, M.D., was issued License Number 0101-052828 to practice medicine and surgery on August 1, 1995, which is scheduled to expire on September 30, 2020.
- 2. Dr. Uchella violated Virginia Code § 54.1-2915(A)(3), (13), and (16) and 18 VAC 85-20-28(A)(3)(a) of the Regulations Governing the Practice of Medicine, Osteopathy, Podiatry and Chiropractic in that on April 25, 2020, while on duty as a contract physician in the pediatric unit of a Virginia hospital, he practiced intubation four times on a stillborn infant without parental consent.
- 3. In a written statement to the Board, Dr. Uchella acknowledged practicing intubation on the infant in order to enhance his skill in this area.

#### CONSENT

Sunday Chinasaokwu Uchella, M.D., by affixing his signature to this Consent Order, agrees to the following:

1. I have been advised to seek advice of counsel prior to signing this document;

- 2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me or my license except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, Virginia Code § 2.2-4000 et seq.;
- 3. I acknowledge that I have the following rights, among others: the right to an informal fact-finding conference before the Board; and the right to representation by counsel;
  - 4. I waive my right to an informal conference;
- 5. I admit to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waive my right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any sanction imposed hereunder in any future judicial or administrative proceeding in which the Board is a party;
- 6. I consent to the entry of the following Order affecting my license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

#### ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Virginia Board of Medicine hereby ORDERS that Sunday Chinasaokwu Uchulla, M.D., is REPRIMANDED.
