ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On August 17, 2020, Disciplinary Panel A of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") issued a Final Decision and Order that concluded, as a matter of law, that James K. Lightfoot, M.D., was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine. Pursuant to the Final Decision and Order, Dr. Lightfoot was reprimanded, his medical license was suspended for five (5) business days, and he was required to comply with certain terms and conditions.

On August 25, 2020, the Board issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the suspension imposed by the Final Decision and Order, placed Dr. Lightfoot on probation for a minimum of one (1) year, and reiterated the remaining terms and conditions.¹ Dr. Lightfoot has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the August 25, 2020 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the August 25, 2020 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
