ORDER

On April 10, 2014, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued an Order for Summary Suspension of License to Practice Medicine that summarily suspended the Maryland medical license of Kamal G. Bangoria, M.D. On June 1, 2015, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Summary Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the summary suspension and placed Dr. Bangoria on probation for a minimum period of one (1) year with certain terms and conditions.

On September 2, 2016, the Panel terminated Dr. Bangoria’s probation and Dr. Bangoria entered into a non-public Disposition Agreement with the Panel that required that he comply with certain terms and conditions.

On June 19, 2019, the Panel issued an Order After Show Cause Hearing that found that Dr. Bangoria had violated the terms and conditions of the September 2, 2016 non-public Disposition Agreement. The Order After Show Cause Hearing reprimanded Dr. Bangoria and placed him on probation for a minimum period of three (3) years with certain terms and conditions.¹

Dr. Bangoria has complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation. It is thus hereby;

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the June 19, 2019 Order After Show Cause Hearing is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
