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**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On October 30, 2017, Disciplinary Panel A (“Panel A”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Charles William Davis, II, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel A found that Dr. Davis had engaged in unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine and allowed a physician assistant to perform advanced duties that were not authorized by the Board as part of a Delegation Agreement.<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to the Consent Order, Dr. Davis was reprimanded, placed on probation for a minimum of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions, and required to pay a \$10,000.00 civil fine. Dr. Davis has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the October 30, 2017 Consent Order and has paid the \$10,000.00 fine. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the October 30, 2017 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the civil fine imposed by the October 30, 2017 Consent Order is **SATISFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further
