ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On November 19, 2021, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Hooman Azmi, M.D., entered into a Consent Order, wherein Panel B concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Azmi failed to meet the appropriate standards for the delivery of quality care and failed to keep adequate medical records.¹ Dr. Azmi was reprimanded, required to permanently cease treating addiction and prescribing and dispensing Methadone and Suboxone, and placed on probation for a minimum period of two (2) years with certain terms and conditions. Dr. Azmi has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the November 19, 2021 Consent Order. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the requirement to permanently cease treating addiction and prescribing Methadone and Suboxone remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the November 19, 2021 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
