ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On August 7, 2015, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Angela L. Gucwa, M.D., entered into a public Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Gucwa had violated her non-public Disposition Agreement with the Board, was guilty of unprofessional conduct in the practice of medicine, was addicted to or habitually abused a narcotic or controlled dangerous substance, and provided professional services while using a narcotic or controlled substance in excess of therapeutic amounts or without valid medical indication. Dr. Gucwa’s medical license was suspended and she was required to comply with certain terms and conditions.

On October 29, 2015, the Panel issued an Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation that terminated the suspension of Dr. Gucwa’s medical license, placed her on probation for a minimum of three years, and required that she comply with certain terms and conditions.

On July 14, 2017, the Panel issued an Order Following Show Cause Hearing that determined that Dr. Gucwa had violated the terms and conditions of the October 29, 2015 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation.¹ The Order Following Show Cause Hearing reprimanded Dr. Gucwa, extended her probation by one year, and required that she comply with certain terms and

conditions. Dr. Gucwa has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the probation imposed by the October 29, 2015 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation and the July 14, 2017 Order After Show Cause Hearing. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the probation imposed by the October 29, 2015 Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation and the July 14, 2017 Order After Show Cause Hearing is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
