**ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION**

On June 30, 2020, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and M. Lisa Attebery, D.O., entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Dr. Attebery was disciplined by the Delaware Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline (the “Delaware Board”) for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action in Maryland.<sup>1</sup> Dr. Attebery was placed on probation and ordered to remain in compliance with the terms and conditions of the May 5, 2020 Delaware Board Consent Agreement. Additionally, it was ordered that the Maryland Board Consent Order remain in effect until the Delaware Board deems it appropriate to terminate the probationary terms and conditions of the May 5, 2020 Delaware Board Consent Agreement.

On February 4, 2022, the Delaware Board issued an Order Lifting Probation that lifted the probationary status imposed on Dr. Attebery’s controlled substance registration number and referenced that the probationary period imposed on her medical license was lifted on September 7, 2021. Dr. Attebery has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of the May 5, 2020 Delaware Board Consent Agreement. It is thus, by the Panel, hereby
