## **ORDER**

On March 17, 2015, the Maryland State Board of Physicians and Joan Smith, D.O, entered into a Consent Order wherein Dr. Smith was reprimanded and placed on probation for a minimum of three years with certain terms and conditions, including the following permanent restrictions on her license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland:

- 1. [Dr. Smith] shall permanently cease prescribing Controlled Dangerous Substances ("CDS") for pain management purposes... However [Dr. Smith] may prescribe CDS to a patient for acute pain but in no event may [Dr. Smith] treat acute pain condition [sic] with more than a five day prescription of CDS. This is a permanent provision and remains in effect even after probation is terminated;
- 2. [Dr. Smith] shall permanently cease prescribing buprenorphine for any purpose; and
- 3. [Dr. Smith] shall not prescribe any medications to immediate family members. This is a permanent condition and remains in effect even after probation is terminated.

Dr. Smith has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the non-permanent terms and conditions of the Consent Order. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the probation imposed by the March 17, 2015 Consent Order is **TERMINATED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the reprimand and the above permanent restrictions on Dr. Smith's license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland remain in effect; and it is further
