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ORDER

On August 10, 2022, the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the "Board") and John Hopkins Bayview Medical Center (the "Respondent") entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Board concluded as a matter of law, that the Respondent failed to report to the Board within ten (10) days, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-413, that, effective August 11, 2021, it did not clear a physician for duty and, that on August 13, 2021, the Physician took a voluntary leave of absence, at least in part, because it had reason to believe that the Physician committed several acts and suffered from a condition which the reporting entity had reason to believe may constitute violations of the Medical Practice Act.¹ The Consent Order required that the Respondent pay a civil penalty of \$2,500.00 within thirty (30) days. The Respondent has paid the \$2,500 civil penalty. It is thus hereby

ORDERED that the penalty imposed by the August 10, 2022 Consent Order has been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT**.
