ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On April 8, 2020, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) issued an *Order for Summary Suspension of License to Practice Respiratory Care*, wherein the Panel summarily suspended Rodney H. Dailey, R.C.P.’s Respiratory Care Practitioner license. On April 23, 2020, the summary suspension was affirmed.

On October 5, 2020, the Panel and Mr. Dailey entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Mr. Dailey was guilty of unprofessional or immoral conduct in the practice of respiratory care, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-5A-17(a)(3), is addicted to or habitually abuses any narcotic or controlled dangerous substance as defined in § 5-101 of the Criminal Law Article, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-5A-17(a)(7), and willfully makes or files a false report in the practice of respiratory care, in violation of Health Occ. § 14-5A-17(a)(10).

The October 5, 2020, Consent Order superseded and terminated the April 8, 2020, *Order of Summary Suspension*. Under the terms and conditions of the Consent Order, Mr. Dailey’s license was suspended for a minimum period of (6) six months and required him to continue enrollment in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”). The Consent Order further outlined that Mr. Dailey may submit a written petition to the Panel to terminate the suspension once he complied with the terms and conditions, and MPRP determined that he is safe to return to the practice of respiratory care.

On June 8, 2021, after consideration of Mr. Dailey's petition to terminate his suspension and with MPRP's recommendation that Mr. Dailey was safe to return to the practice of respiratory care, the Panel issued an *Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation*¹ terminating the suspension imposed by the October 5, 2020, Consent Order and ordered that Mr. Dailey be placed on probation for a minimum period of four (4) years with terms and conditions, including his continued enrollment with MPRP.

Mr. Dailey has fully and satisfactorily complied with the probationary terms and conditions imposed by the *Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation*, and four (4) years have passed.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the June 8, 2021, *Order Terminating Suspension and Imposing Probation* are **TERMINATED**²; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
