ORDER

On September 18, 2024, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Christina Tappert, entered into a Consent Order, wherein the Panel concluded, as a matter of law, that Ms. Tappert was disciplined by the Pennsylvania State Board of Medicine for an act or acts that would be grounds for disciplinary action in Maryland.¹ The Consent Order granted Ms. Tappert’s Respiratory Care Practitioner Application for Licensure, reprimanded her, and ordered her to comply with certain terms and conditions, including that she enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program “MPRP” and comply with all of MPRP’s referrals, rules, and requirements.

Ms. Tappert has fully and satisfactorily complied with the terms and conditions imposed by the Consent Order dated September 18, 2024.

It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the conditions imposed by the September 18, 2024 Consent Order have been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
