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ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

On July 25, 2023, Disciplinary Panel B (the “Panel”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Moses Tibo, Radiographer, entered into a non-public Disposition Agreement (the “Agreement”), wherein Mr. Tibo agreed to enroll in the Maryland Professional Rehabilitation Program (“MPRP”), comply with all of MPRP’s recommendations, and fulfill all conditions of the Participant Rehabilitation Agreement (“PRA”).

On March 20, 2024, after the Panel issued a Violation of Disposition Agreement and Notice to Show Cause and after a Show Cause Hearing, the Panel issued an Order After Show Cause Hearing (the “Order”),¹ wherein it was concluded as a matter of law, that Mr. Tibo violated the terms and conditions of the Agreement by failing to comply with terms of his MPRP PRA.

The Order terminated the July 25, 2023 Agreement, reprimanded him, and placed him on probation for a minimum period of six (6) months with certain terms and conditions, including that he re-enroll in MPRP, comply with all of MPRP’s recommendations, and fulfill all conditions of the PRA.

Mr. Tibo has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and six (6) months have passed. It is thus, by the Panel, hereby

ORDERED that the probation and probationary terms and conditions imposed by the March 20, 2024 Order are **TERMINATED**; and it is further

ORDERED that the reprimand imposed by the March 20, 2024 Order remains in effect; and it is further

ORDERED that this is a public document.
