**ORDER**

On September 27, 2022, Disciplinary Panel A (“Panel A”) of the Maryland State Board of Physicians (the “Board”) and Suburban Hospital (the “Respondent”) entered into a Pre-Notice Consent Order, wherein Panel A concluded as a matter of law, that the Respondent failed to notify the Board within ten (10) days that it limited, reduced, otherwise changed, or terminated Radiographer 1 and Radiographer 2’s employment for reasons that might be grounds for disciplinary action under the following provisions of Health Occ § 14-5B-14(a): (3) Is guilty of unprofessional or immoral conduct in the practice of radiation therapy, radiography, nuclear medicine technology, or radiology assistance; and/or (18) fails to meet appropriate standards for the delivery of quality radiation therapy, radiography, nuclear medicine technology, or radiology assistant care performed in any outpatient surgical facility, office hospital or related institution, or any other location in this State. The Respondent’s failure to report Radiographer 1 and Radiographer 2’s termination to the Board within ten (10) days for reasons that might be grounds for disciplinary action under Health Occ. § 14-5B-14, as described above, constitutes a violation of Health Occ. § 14-5B-15.<sup>1</sup> The

Pre-Notice Consent Order required that the Respondent pay a civil penalty of \$1,500.00 within thirty (30) days. The Respondent has paid the \$1,500 civil penalty. It is thus hereby

**ORDERED** that the penalty imposed by the September 27, 2022 Pre-Notice Consent Order has been **SATISFIED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that this is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT**.
